

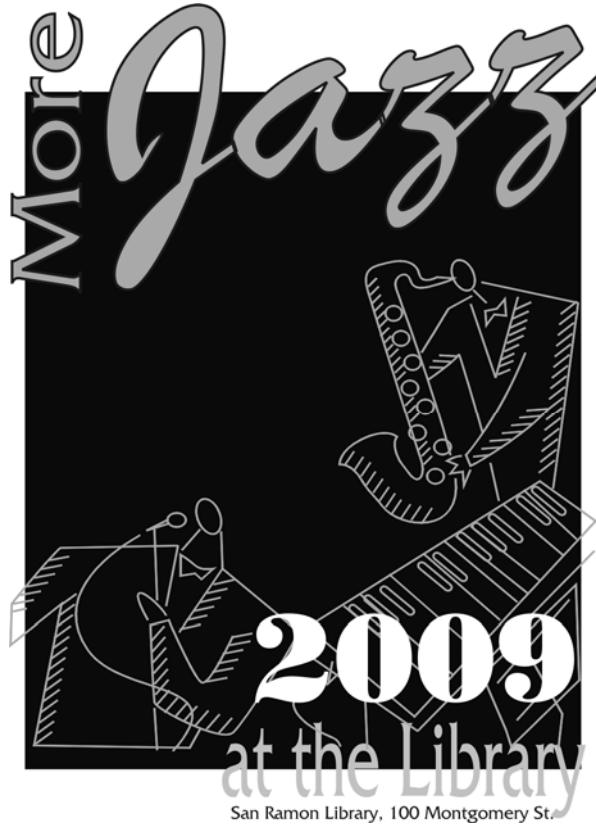

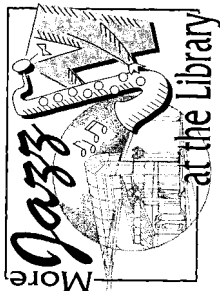

Art was one of the original members of the San Ramon Library Jazz Committee that created this series of jazz concerts in 1996 when the Beyond Category: Duke Ellington Exhibit came to San Ramon. Art made stellar contributions to music education, music performance, and music legislation in our area and for all Californians. A District Music Supervisor and music instructor in the San Ramon Unified School District for over 30 years, Art was also a "first call" alto saxophone player in San Francisco and played lead alto in jazz bands for many stars who performed in San Francisco.
